

## Checklist of preliminary examinations

### Female examination findings:

#### Blood tests

- Hormonal assays (taken between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> day of menstrual cycle)  
LH, FSH, estradiol, prolactin, testosterone and TSH, TPO antibodies
- Infectious serology:  
Rubella antibodies, HIV, TPHA, HBs antigens, Anti Hbc, Hep C antibodies
- Blood coagulation: APC-resistance = Activated protein C

#### Gynecological checkup

- Examination findings of gynecologic checkup: PAP smear and cervical bacterial culture including chlamydia

### Male examination findings:

#### Blood tests

- Infectious serology:  
HIV, TPHA, HBS antigen, Anti Hbc, Hep C antibodies

#### Semen analysis

- a current spermiogramm (according to WHO-criteria)
